THE PSALTER OF THE 1962 ROMAN BREVIARY

This guide to the Psalter applies to the last edition of the Roman Breviary before the Liturgy of the Hours was introduced in 1970. The Roman Breviary went through few changes (although there were frequent changes to the calendar) in the 10 year period between 1960 and 1970. This chart guides you through the Church's last schema of the traditional 1 week Psalter. The chart is laid out simply so that any hour of the Divine Office can be prayed on any day of the week. The I, II, and III of Matins refers to the 3 Nocturns of that hour. The chapter and verse numbers were referenced from the Clementine Vulgate which correspond to the English Douay Rheims (Challoner revision) version.

Please note there are 5 footnotes that further explain some of the variances that occur.

1. A second scheme of Lauds is given for use "...on days with a penitential character. Thus, scheme II is used on the Sundays from Septuagesima to the second Passion Sunday inclusive. It is also used in the ferial offices of Advent and in ferial Offices from Septuagesima to the second Passion Sunday; in the ferial Office of the Ember Days of September; in the ferial Office of vigils of the II and III class outside of Paschaltide. The Ordo will always indicate which scheme is to be used." Taken from page 33 of *Learning the New Breviary* by Bernard A. Hausmann, S.J., Benziger Brothers, 1961
2. Psalm 9 is divided into two parts. The first part, Psalm 9. The second, labeled Psalm 10 according to the Hebrews which starts over with verse number 1.
3. "On Sundays from Septuagesima up until the Second Sunday of the Passion, inclusive, on the vigil and the octave day of Christmas, during the Sacred Triduum, on first class feasts, on days within the octaves of Easter and Pentecost, at Prime, Terce, Sext, and None, the psalms of Sunday are said with antiphons proper to the Office of the day, unless there is a special mention to the contrary: but at Prime instead of Psalm 117 the following psalm is said: [Psalm 53]" Taken from page 103P of *The Roman Breviary* edited by Rev. 4. The III nocturn of Matins for Wednesday is given in two schemes. "**Scheme I-** On ferias throughout the year, except on vigils and on the Ember Days of September, on ferias in Christmastide and Paschaltide, on the vigils of Christmas and the Ascension, and on feasts celebrated in any time of the year when Psalm 50 is not said at Lauds." "**Scheme II-** On the ferias of Advent, and from the Wednesday after Septuagesima Sunday up until the Wednesday in Holy Week inclusive, also on the Ember Days of September and on vigils of the second and third class outside of Paschaltide, when Psalm 50 is said at Lauds." 5. The 4th and 5th Psalms of this hour are divided in the middle of verse 13.
